Background – The event takes step from the <u>IV Adriatic Ionian Youth Organisations Forum</u> (AIYOF4) organised by the Adriatic Ionian Euroregion (AIE) as part of the <u>AI-NURECC PLUS</u> Initiative in Skopje (North Macedonia) on 24 January 2023.

It will be an occasion to continue reflecting on the challenges of the *green and digital transition* and on the EU opportunities that young people need to be prepared to seize in order to face them. Momentous topics such as *brain drain and brain circulation* in the Adriatic Ionian Region will be discussed as key to progressing towards environmental sustainability, innovation and social inclusion. A special attention will be given to the perspectives of youth organisations and to reflect upon the role they can play in decision-making processes, especially with reference to the introduction of a potential fifth social pillar in the EUSAIR. Suggestions from the other macroregional strategies will be sought and incorporated in the reflections about establishing an open dialogue and cooperation on these matters.
